

- **SMA SCANNER**

- The scanning surface is 48 in x 70 in. This is the only scanner like it in Michigan.
- It is used to scan documents, books, and artwork that are created on flat surfaces, old pictures, and some fabrics. This machine is used to capture quick and sharp images of the object being scanned.
- The SMA can scan multiple images at a time in a "batch scan" and can also cut out each image separately during the scanning process. The final images will be saved on the customers USB, Hard drive, etc.
- The price point for this machine is broken up into 4 quadrants of the glass surface. The smallest size being \$35, then \$55, \$70, and \$82.50. The price for scanning on this machine can also be determined by the size of the project and how much needs to be scanned. This can be discussed on a per project basis.
- Depending on the project size, a customer can be trained to operate the scanner, which in turn would reduce the price. This is specific for mass scanning projects.



- **EPSON V750 SCANNER**

- Our Epson V750 scanner is used for scanning smaller images at a much higher resolution allowing much larger enlargements. It can also scan negatives and slides of various sizes.
- The area to scan is 8.5 in x 11.5 in. Just like the Cruse scanner, if we need to scan the image in sections and stitch it together, we can.
- The price point for this machine is based on the resolution the image is being scanned at. This can be discussed per each project.
